

CONDITIONS OF FIELD USE

Field is defined as – all the grass area inside the ring fence including the tar seal ring road.

The purpose of these conditions is to;

- a) Protect the field from unnecessary damage.
- b) Avoid charges against clients for inappropriate use.

1. Prior to any event starting, it would be beneficial for all concerned that a meeting be held with the client and RDC staff (Events & Parks Ground staff representative) to ensure all are familiar with the event and to clarify the following three points and to work through options/solutions.

2. Vehicles

- a) Are only permitted into the area with approval of RDC staff
- b) Approval for vehicles to enter the area will depend on:
 - Vehicle is suitable type/size
 - Vehicle is not going to discharge/drop contaminants
 - Vehicle driver is prepared to meet any conditions RDC staff request
- c) The ring road is in place for usage by approved vehicles, any driving on the grass is prohibited and is only possible if RDC ground staff is onsite and gives permission and monitor.

Note: It is possible that RDC could provide (at an agreed cost) a small quad bike type vehicle and trailer for distributing equipment etc.

3. Structures/Covers etc

- a) No item is to be brought into the area without RDC staff approval
- b) No item is to be left sitting on the grass for more than 72 hours without RDC staff approval
- c) All items to be free of contaminants that would adversely affect the turf. RDC staff could ask the client to remove or clean the item, should this happen.

4. Field Closed

- a) On a regular basis, ground staff carry out maintenance work (including tractor work – chemical applications etc), at these times. From a Health and Safety point, when these signs are up, clients must not enter the field area.
- b) These are times when ground conditions are unsuitable for use (any use at this time could be detrimental to the field, costly to repair and impact on future uses).
- c) Field closed signs will be erected during these times at the tunnel and the two main entrance gates.
